UW Eau Claire's Boys Badger Basketball Camp is one of the most popular camps in the entire Midwest with over 42,400 participants attending since it began. This year we will be entering our 45th year instructing basketball fundamentals. We will be offering four different camp sessions — a Morning Day Camp and three Weeklong Overnight Camp sessions where meals and lodging are provided on the scenic UW-Eau Claire campus. Our camps offer fierce competition, a talented group of basketball instructors and a variety of activities for the week. The camp is under the direction of Blugold head coach Terry Gibbons, who runs one of the most successful basketball programs in the nation. Come experience the tradition of Blugold Basketball first hand!

SESSIONS 1, 2, AND 3 — REGISTRATION AND COST

ON-CAMPUS RESIDENTS: \$340 — Check-in will be on Sunday for Sessions 1 and 3, and Monday for Session 2 from 4–6:00 p.m. in the lobby of Oak Ridge Residence Hall on UW-Eau Claire's upper campus. Check-out will be at 11 a.m. on Friday for Sessions 1 and 3, and Saturday for Session 2. This is a week of basketball — 15 sessions, 14 meals and 5 nights.

COMMUTERS: \$290 — Check-in will be at 6:30 p.m. in the McPhee Physical Education Center. Commuter Campers will arrive in the morning and will be allowed to leave camp following their final game in the evening. Lunch and dinner will be provided.

SESSIONS 4 — REGISTRATION AND COST

DAY CAMP: \$90 — Campers will attend from 9 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Monday-Friday, in Zorn Arena. Check-in will be on Monday at 9 a.m.

HOW CAN I ENROLL?

Simply fill out the enclosed application form and send it along with your payment. For Sessions 1, 2 and 3, please send a \$100 deposit with the balance due at the time of check-in. For Session 4, the full \$90 registration fee is required. Make checks or money orders payable to UW-Eau Claire Badger Basketball Camp and mail to the address on the application form. Registration and payments also may be made with Discover, MasterCard, or VISA by calling Tammy at (715) 836-2546. Upon receipt of application, we will e-mail a confirmation letter and additional information. Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, so register early. CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations must be received two weeks prior to camp date. After this date, refunds will only be issued for medical reasons provided by a physician. For Sessions 1, 2 and 3, \$75 will be refunded. For Session 4, \$65 will be refunded. Once the camp session begins, no refunds will be issued.

LODGING AND MEALS

Campers who choose to stay on campus will be housed, two to a room, in Oak Ridge Hall on upper campus. Campers receive constant supervision — 24-hour security service is provided, and counselors and coaches room on the same floor. All bedding is supplied. Resident campers will have three all-you-can-eat meals per day provided by the University Food Service. These meals will be at the beautiful Hilltop Center Food Court on upper campus. Commuter campers will be provided lunch and dinner at Hilltop Center.

TRAINER AND MEDICAL AID

A first responder will be available at all times. A modern clinic and hospital are located within a half mile of camp. Physicians are on call at all times. In the event your child receives medical care at any time, you will be notified immediately. Each camper must have his own insurance. Parents are responsible for ensuring their child is in good physical condition when they come to camp.

TRANSPORTATION

Campers arriving by car can come directly to Oak Ridge Hall on the University's upper campus. Those traveling by bus or plane can make arrangements with the camp staff to be picked up when they arrive.

2010 REGISTRATION

Upon receipt of camper's application and deposit, a confirmation letter will be e-mailed along with health and insurance forms. These must be returned at least two weeks prior to your camp date. ASST. COACH KEITH MUCHOW



Muchow enters his fourth season as top assistant for the Blugold men's basketball team, after spending five seasons as a volunteer assistant coach for the Blugolds. Muchow is also a strength coordinator at UW-Eau Claire. Muchow has coached at various camps and coaching clinics throughout the region.

PHILOSOPHY

The UW-Eau Claire Badger Basketball Camp subscribes to the theory that "Basketball teams are made during the season; basketball players are made during the off-season." Our talented coaches teach each camper to properly execute the fundamentals of the game, stressing hard work on the court. We also will focus on areas of character, sportsmanship, ethics and goal setting.

FUNDAMENTALS

Individualized attention will be given to each camper in teaching the fundamentals of basketball including dribbling, passing, offensive movement with the ball (facing basket and with back to basket), rebounding, offensive moves without the ball (cutting and getting open), position play and emphasis on individual and team defensive techniques. Coaches also will work with each camper on the basic fundamentals of shooting. Ball and hand position, body alignment, squaring up and eye contact will be stressed.

GAMES

Every camper will participate on a team that will play officiated games each day. No more than eight campers will be on a team to ensure that every participant has an ample opportunity to play. These games allow campers to put into practice what they learned during the day.



ACTIVITIES

Campers will participate in contests, games and lectures, but the emphasis will be on individual instruction and activity on the court. Our talented coaching staff will work closely with campers in developing the proper execution of basketball fundamentals. Our staff is committed to every camper becoming an improved basketball player, mentally as well as physically.

AGE DIVISIONS

Campers are divided according to age and ability for instruction and games. The pace of instruction is geared to the age of the camper. Current playing experience and ability are not a factor in being accepted to UW-Eau Claire Badger Basketball Camp.

GROUP REGISTRATION

During Sessions 1, 2 and 3, campers wishing to play and drill together as a team may indicate so when applying. All members should send in their camp applications together as a team. During league play, a full team will consist of no more than eight campers. Groups larger than eight will still be allowed to practice together throughout the week. This is an excellent way to work with your teammates and improve as a group.

EVALUATIONS

Each camper will receive a personal, written evaluation with constructive comments on the fundamental areas of the game. This evaluation will include information that can be used at home to further improve skills and techniques of basketball. Each camper also will receive a certificate of merit and other awards.
