

#### **UW-EAU CLAIRE BADGER BASKETBALL CAMP**

UW-Eau Claire's Boys Badger Basketball Camp is one of the most popular camps in the entire Midwest with over 42,800 participants attending since it began. This year we will be entering our 46th year instructing basketball fundamentals. We will be offering five different camp sessions—a morning day camp, two specialty camps on shooting and motion offense, and two overnight camp sessions where meals and lodging are provided on the scenic UW-Eau Claire campus. Our camps offer fierce competition, a talented group of basketball instructors and a variety of activities for the week. The camp is under the direction of Blugold head coach Terry Gibbons, who runs one of the most successful basketball programs in the nation. Come experience the tradition of Blugold Basketball first hand!

**SESSIONS 1 AND 2 – Resident and Commuter Camps** REGISTRATION AND COST - On-Campus Residents: \$320 - Checkin will be on Sunday for Sessions 1 and 2 from 4-6:00 p.m. in the lobby of Oak Ridge Residence Hall on UW-Eau Claire's upper campus. Check-out will be at 11 a.m. on Thursday. This is five days of basketball — 13 sessions, 11 meals and 4 nights.

Commuters: \$270 - Check-in will be Sunday at 6:30 p.m. in the McPhee Physical Education Center. Commuter Campers will arrive in the morning and will be allowed to leave camp following their final game in the evening. Lunch and dinner will be provided.

#### **EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION**

Register for any camp session by May 15th and receive a 5% discount.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Cancellations must be received two weeks prior to camp date. After this date, refunds will only be issued for medical reasons provided by a physician. For all sessions, the registration fee minus a \$25 service fee will be refunded. Once the camp session begins, no refunds will be issued.

#### **LODGING AND MEALS**

Campers who choose to stay on campus will be housed, two to a room, in Oak Ridge Hall on upper campus. Campers receive constant supervision – 24-hour security service is provided, and counselors and coaches room on the same floor. All bedding is supplied. Resident campers will have three all-you-can-eat meals per day provided by the University Food Service. These meals will be at the beautiful Hilltop Center Food Court on upper campus. Commuter campers will be provided lunch and dinner at Hilltop Center.

#### **TRAINER AND MEDICAL AID**

A first responder will be available at all times. A modern clinic and hospital are located within a half mile of camp. Physicians are on call at all times. In the event your child receives medical care at any time, you will be notified immediately. Each camper must have his own insurance. Parents are responsible for ensuring their child is in good physical condition when they come to camp.

#### 2011 CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

**Resident and Commuter Camp** 

Session 1: Sunday, July 10 - Thursday, July 14 Session 2: Sunday, July 24 - Thursday, July 28 McPhee Phy Ed Center • Grades 5-12

This overnight camp will focus on the development of the basket-ball player during this five day camp. Individualized attention will be given to each camper in the teaching of fundamentals of basketball. Our talented coaching staff will work closely with campers in developing the proper execution of these fundamentals. We are committed to every camper becoming an improved basketball player mentally as well as physically. During the week, campers will also participate in lectures, contests, and games.

#### GAMES

Every camper will participate on a team that will play officiated games each day. No more than eight campers will be on a team to ensure that every participant has an ample opportunity to play. These games allow campers to put into practice what they learned during the day.

#### AGE DIVISIONS

Campers are divided according to age and ability for instruction and tournament play. The pace of instruction is geared to the age and ability of the camper. Current playing experience and ability are not a factor in being accepted to UW-Eau Claire Badger Basketball Camp.


#### GROUP REGISTRATION

During Sessions 1 and 2, campers wishing to participate as a team may indicate so when applying. All members can send registration together or send a list of campers wishing to participate together with registration. During league play, a full team will consist of no more than eight campers. Groups larger than eight will still be allowed to work together during daily camp sessions.

### EVALUATIONS

Each camper will receive a personal, written evaluation with constructive comments on the fundamental areas of the game. This evaluation will include information that can be used at home to further improve skills and techniques of basketball. Each camper will also receive a certificate of merit as well as individual and team awards.

Grades 3-8 \$80 | 9 a.m.-12 noon SESSION 3 - *Fundamentals Day Camp* Monday, July 18 - Thursday, July 21

#### Session 3: Fundamentals Day Camp Monday, July 18 - Thursday, July 21 (9 a.m.-12 noon), Zorn Arena • Grades 3-8

This day camp will focus on the development of basic fundamental skills used in all aspects of the game of basketball. Campers will participate in small group instruction focusing on dribbling, passing, shooting, and offensive and defensive movement. In addition, campers will participate in various contests, Blugold drills and league play. Head coach Terry Gibbons will be the lead instructor at this camp, assisted by Assistant Coach Keith Muchow. Group size is limited to twenty campers so be sure to register early. **COST: \$80** 

## Session 4: *Shooting Camp*Monday, July 18 - Tuesday, July 19 (5-8 p.m.) Zorn Arena • Grades 7-12

This specialty camp will focus on the proper shooting fundamentals and technique. Campers will receive individual and small group instruction on all aspects of shooting, including footwork, mechanics, and three-point shooting. In addition, campers will each receive a personal written evaluation. Blugold Head Coach Terry Gibbons will be the lead instructor at this specialized camp, assisted by Assistant Coach Keith Muchow. Group size is limited to twenty campers so be sure to register early. **COST: \$45** 

### Session 5: *Motion Camp*Wednesday, July 20 - Thursday, July 21 (5-8 p.m.) Zorn Arena • Grades 7-12

This specialty camp will focus on the proper fundamentals of motion offense. Campers will receive individual and small group instruction on all aspects of running a motion offense including passing, screening, and cutting. In addition, campers will receive a personal written evaluation. UW-Eau Claire Head Coach Terry Gibbons will be the lead instructor at this specialized camp, assisted by Assistant Coach Keith Muchow. Group size is limited to twenty campers so be sure to register early. **COST: \$45**
