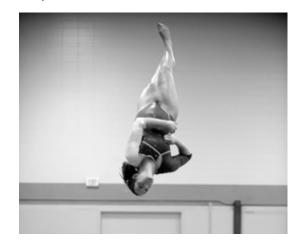

Camp Director

The camp is directed by Erin Bolstad. Erin is the assistant coach of the UW-Eau Claire women's gymnastics team and the director of the Jr. Blugold Gymnastics program. This is her eighth year coaching the Blugolds and her sixth year directing the UW-Eau Claire gymnastics summer camp. She and head coach Jean DeLisle have the led the Blugolds to three consecutive appearances at the NCGA National Championships and have coached two individual national champions and one conference champion.

Camp Staff

Our coaches and instructors are selected for their outstanding abilities in training and guidance of gymnasts of all ages and talents. Staff members are well known and respected for their knowledge and experience in gymnastics. Members of the UW-Eau Claire gymnastics team add their expertise to the camp staff.

Lodging and Meals

Campers who choose to stay on campus will be housed, two to a room, in Murray Residence Hall on upper campus. Campers receive constant supervision; 24-hour security service is provided and counselors room on the same floor. All bedding is supplied. Resident campers will have three "all-you-can-eat" meals per day, provided by the University Food Service. These meals will be at the beautiful Hilltop Center on upper campus. The first meal is Sunday supper and the last is Friday breakfast. Lunch and supper will be provided for commuters.

What to Bring

Campers should bring workout clothes, grips, swimsuit, towels, and spending money. Resident campers also should bring an electric fan and toiletries. Pillows, blankets and sheets are provided.

Registration and Cost

To register, fill out the attached form and return it with your full payment or a \$50 non-refundable minimum deposit. Balances are due no later than July 8, 2011.

Dorm Residents

\$400/week or **\$750** for both weeks. Includes tuition, housing, meals and camp T-shirt.

Commuters

\$295/week or **\$550** for both weeks. Includes tuition, lunch, dinner, and camp T-shirt.

Check in will be in the lobby of your assigned residence hall on upper campus at UW-Eau Claire. Residents will check in on Sunday from 4:30-5:45 p.m. Commuters will check in on Sunday from 5:45-6:00 p.m. Camp welcome, staff introductions and group placement will follow registration at the McPhee Physical Education Center. Commuters arrive at camp in the morning and will be allowed to leave camp for dinner only (4:00-5:45 p.m.).

Cancellation Policy

\$50 will be refunded if camper cancellation is received two weeks prior to camp date. Once camp begins, there are no refunds except for medical reasons.
