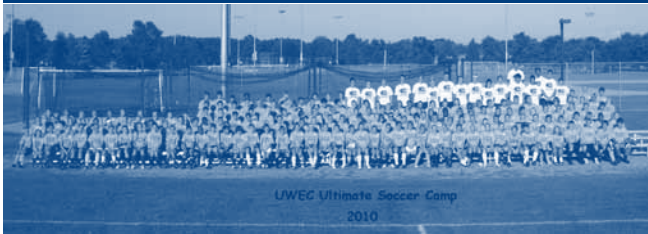

### Camp Philosophy

Everything included in the UW-Eau Claire Soccer Camp's curriculum meets two objectives concerning soccer: fun and progress. Any athlete finds the mental concentration and physical effort necessary for success come easily when the activity provides enjoyment. With this in mind, the program includes varied, imaginative exercises designed to resemble actual match conditions. Each of these exercises targets one of four facets of play.

First, we expand the player's vision on the field. Second, we teach the player the proper reactions to what he or she sees: the vision cues and their tactical implications. Third, we improve the player's technical ability to put his or her decision into action. Finally, we increase the pace at which the player puts all three together: vision, decision, and execution. Above all, we teach together soccer is fun. We try to eliminate any fear of trying positive things and the fear of failure.

### Age and grade requirements

All age and grade requirements are as of Sept. 2011. Exceptions can be made by contacting the camp director. Ultimate Soccer Camp: grades 6-12.

### Discipline

Any serious violation of Camp regulations (like damage to university property, disrespect to coaches or other behavior deemed detrimental to the group) will result in immediate dismissal from camp. If a camper is dismissed or voluntarily withdraws from the camp, there will be no refund. Drugs, alcohol and tobacco are not allowed.

### Accommodations

Campers will be housed in a comfortable dormitory on campus with two people to a room. Counselors live on the floors with the campers; thus campers will be under constant supervision. All bedding will be provided but not towels. Meals will be served in the college's Hilltop dining hall. Commuters will only be served lunch and dinner.

### Check out

Ultimate Soccer Camp ends at 11:00 a.m. July 29. Commuters can be picked up at the fields and resident campers can be picked up at 12:00 at the dormitory.

### Equipment needs

Bring your own soccer ball (one will be provided but not until the end of camp), water bottle, shin guards, cleats, sneakers, duffle bag, and swimsuit.
