

Men's Hockey Looks To Keep Momentum Going this Weekend

EAU CLAIRE - Fresh off its first win of the season the UW-Eau Claire men's hockey team will look to keep the momentum going as it will host St. Olaf College on Friday night and Gustavus Adolphus on Saturday night.

The Blugolds will come in with a 1-11-3 record overall after defeating Concordia-Moorhead 5-3 on Saturday for the team's first win of the season.

The Blugolds are led by **Chip Dunleavy** (*Sr.-Littleton, CO/Columbine*), who leads the team in points this season with 10. He also leads the team in goals with six. Five of his six goals are power-play goals. **Brooks Lockwood** (*Jr.-Hudson*) is second on the team in points with nine and in goals with five.

Blugold goalie **Steffan Braunlich** (*Sr.-Los Angeles, CA/Loyola*) has stopped 317 shots this season and has only allowed 38 goals.

The Blugolds' opponent Friday night, St. Olaf, will come in with a 3-5-4 record overall. The Oles are led by Kyle Hilmershausen, who leads the team in points with eight. The Blugolds are 12-7 all-time against the Oles and have won the last two meetings between the schools.

The Blugolds will face Gustavus Adolphus on Saturday night. The Gusties have a record of 9-2-0 this season and are on a six-game winning streak. Leading the Gusties in points this season is Keith Detlefsen with 21. Leading the Gusties in goals are Loren Havemeier and Mike Hosfield who each have nine. The Blugolds are 4-8 all-time against Gustavus. The Blugolds defeated the Gusties last season 5-2, after losing the three previous meetings.

Friday night's game against St. Olaf begins 7 p.m. Saturday night's game against Gustavus also begins at 7 p.m. Both games will take place at Hobbs Ice Center.
